## CANDIDATE SELECTION PROGRAM

The Glynn County Democratic Party intends to do its part to “Turn Georgia Blue” by electing Democratic candidates up and down the ballot.

To achieve our goal at the local level, we must ensure that qualified, capable and well-funded candidates run for local offices – that could be you.

### CANDIDATE SELECTION PROCESS

To succeed, we will build the profile and viability of the Democratic Party in Glynn County by giving voters a better choice at the ballot box. We recruit, select, train and support qualified candidates.

Because the Democratic Party in Glynn County may not endorse candidates in a contested primary election, we will use our best efforts to encourage candidates to run for an office where they will be unopposed in the primary.

In contested Democratic primaries, we cannot support or endorse one candidate over another until a winner is chosen to run in the general election.

## TRAINING RESOURCES FOR DEMOCRATS

Some of the available training resources:

**Camp Wellstone** (Wellstone.org) is taught by some of the nation’s leading experts in grassroots politics and organizing. It offers training for candidates, campaign workers, and organizers on how to win progressive change.

**Emerge America** (EmergeAmerica.org) is about changing the face of politics by recruiting and training Democratic women to run for office. It offers six-month, 70-hour, training programs in 21 states.

**Emily’s List** (EmilysList.org) offers expert staff to pro-choice Democratic women running for federal and gubernatorial offices. Their expert staff helps craft effective fundraising, political, communications and digital strategies.

**The Victory Fund** (VictoryFund.org) offers intensive four-day candidate and campaign training providing LGBTQ leaders with the tools and skills to develop a winning campaign strategy.

**Ignite** (IgniteNational.org) is building a movement of young women eager to become the next generation of political leaders by training young women from high schools, colleges and universities nationwide.

**The National Democratic Training Committee** (TrainDemocrats.org) offers free, interactive online campaign training for any Democratic candidate in local and state races. The training covers how to build field plans, messaging and media, fundraising and management.

**She Should Run** (SheShouldRun.org) is a non-partisan organization that provides a starting place and network for women leaders considering a run for office and for those who support them.

## RECRUITING CANDIDATES

- Candidate recruitment will be promoted with a multimedia campaign that includes our websites, public notices, advertising, social media and our events.
- We will meet with potential candidates to assess their qualifications to determine their eligibility and competitiveness and to recommend the race for them.
- Candidates seeking Party support and endorsement will enter into a Support and Endorsement Agreement that will govern party support and candidate participation.
- Support for candidates includes:
  - Inclusion in Democratic literature
  - Volunteer teams for phone banking and canvassing
  - Work space at the party headquarters
  - Public speaking engagements
  - Marketing and branding
  - Voter forums
