Puddy Smith and Dr. Markisha Butler are running for “At-Large” positions on the County Commission and the Board of Education, respectively? This means that *all* voters in Glynn County, no matter which District they live in, may vote for them.

NEWS FROM THE DISTRICTS: *KNOW YOUR PRECINCT, GET INVOLVED*

Each of the five County Commission Districts is divided into smaller areas called precincts. Everyone who lives in a certain precinct votes in the same place in elections. Most people identify their precinct by the name of the voting place. The precincts within each district in Glynn County are listed below.

District 1 – Sterling Elementary School, Marshes of Glynn Baptist Church, Satilla Marsh Elementary School, Blythe Island Baptist Church

District 2 – Christian Renewal Church, Oglethorpe Elementary School, St. Williams Catholic Church (temporarily at Fire Station #2), St. Simons First Baptist Church, Jekyll Presbyterian Church

District 3 – Sterling Church of God, SE Baptist Association Building, Glynn County Career Academy, C.B. Greer Elementary School

District 4 -- Ballard Community Center, Northside Baptist Church, The Chapel, College Place United Methodist Church (307)

District 5 – College Place United Methodist Church (308), Howard Coffin Park, Zion Baptist Church, Selden Park

to serve "At-Large," which means that those representatives may live anywhere in the county and are elected by all Democrats. Half of the Committee posts (called "Gubernatorial positions because they are filled in years when the Governor is elected) will be up for election this year. (Watch for notices.) All Glynn Democrats are encouraged to attend the caucus elections to vote for your representatives on the Committee.

With few exceptions, the Committee holds its Issues Forum general meetings on the 4th Monday of each month at 7 p.m. Please, plan to attend these upcoming meetings:

June 25th Meeting at 2018 Campaign Headquarters -- Otha Thornton, Jr. of Richmond Hill, will be our speaker. He is in a run-off to be elected as the Democratic nominee for State School Superintendent to run in the general election against the Republican incumbent. Sid Chapman of Griffin, also in the run-off for the Democratic nomination, has been invited to attend, as well, but has not confirmed that he can be present.

August 18th – GLYNN DEMS ANNUAL DINNER, 6-9 p.m. at Selden Park. Our slate of candidates up and down the ticket will be the featured speakers. Tickets are on sale now at \$50 per person.
